

Barrow Hedges Primary School Sports Funding Expenditure Report: 1st April 2017 –31st March 2018

The total amount of money to be received for Sports Funding between 1st April 2017 and 31st March 2018 is 1st instalment £4460 (received May 2017) and 2nd instalment £6245 (predicted). Actual total - £10705 with additional funding available from CPFC £12400

Ofsted (February 2015) stated: "The primary sport and physical education funding is used effectively to buy in specialist coaches who teach some lessons and help to improve the skills of class teachers. This is helping pupils' progress in physical education both now and in the longer term. The school has good relationships with parents."

Providing transport to events means that parents are less reluctant to let their child take part as we are able to get them there. Although the overall cost of transport has increased we have reduced our costs by £450 as there is one 1 cross country race this year and not 4 (a coach to cross country is £150). Due to a shortage of drivers Sutton Community Transports have been unable to meet all our transport requirements. Alternative providers have meant an increase in costs.
