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Our Day!



- Harbury Road and Radcliffe Garden Gate will be supervised by a member of the Admin or Leadership Team from 8.40am. Children then come in to school for a relaxed start. School starts at 8:55. The gates are closed and locked promptly
- If you are late (before or after school) you need to go to the office
- If someone else is picking up your child please write in our home school collection book at the beginning of the day
- If your child is off sick or absent from school for any other reason, you need to call the office (48 hours rule)
- In Reception we learn through play, carpet sessions and focussed group activities will increase throughout the year
- Water/fruit and milk is available throughout the day, you do not need to provide a water bottle

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Clothing



- Please ensure your child wears the correct school uniform everyday
- No trainers
- Your child will need a PE kit from October half term. We will remind you closer to the time. Your child will come dressed in their PE kit.
- Please dress your child for the weather – we go outside EVERY DAY
- Please send extra clothes in a bag to leave on your child's peg in case of accidents.
- If we send home spare clothes please return cleaned as soon as possible.
- Children are not allowed to wear any jewellery, except watches, long hair must be tied back, this includes girls and boys.
- School policy states that girls hair accessories remain small and simple.
- Nail polish and fake tattoos are not allowed.

We give stickers to reward good behaviour.

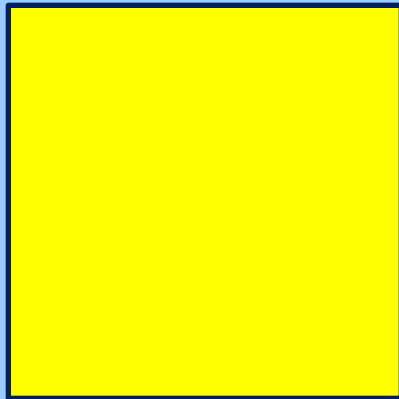


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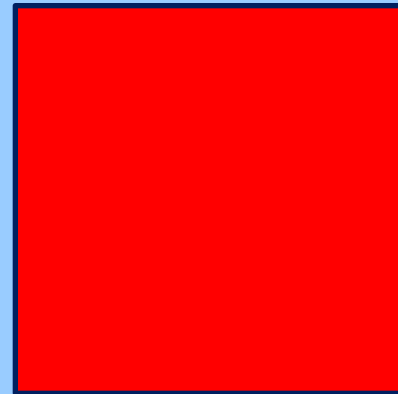

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




My Writing
