Day 1	All about me! Draw a picture of yourself. Look in the mirror to see what colour eyes you have. Can you make marks or write your name?	Read a book to your child. Encourage them to talk about the pictures. What can you see?	Watch these number rhymes. Can you join in? https://www.youtube.com/watch?time_continue=6&v=Oa8ExjxRMB8&feature=emb_logo
Day 2	What is your favourite food? Can you help with the cooking of your favourite meal? Share a picture of your cooking!	Watch this story of Harry and the bucketful of dinosaurs. Can you remember any of the dinosaurs in his bucket? https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=uWoopkMgLqM	Can you sing one of the number rhymes from yesterday. How many of your toys can you count?
Day 3	Talk to your grown up about who is in your family. Can you draw them? Can you write their names or make marks?	Read a book to your child. Encourage them to talk about the pictures. What can you see? Can you retell the story?	Play the teddy counting game. Can you give him 5 cakes? https://www.topmarks.co.uk/mathsgames/3-5-years/counting
Day 4	Go on a colour hunt. Can you find a rainbow of colours around your house? Take photographs of what you find!	Watch the story of Elmer. How was Elmer different to the other elephants? https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=abVx9_dPKq8	Play a counting game. What about Ladybird spots? https://www.topmarks.co.uk/mathsgames/3-5-years/counting

Day 5	Draw a picture of your favourite toy or TV character. Tell your grown up everything you know about them. Can you write what it is?	Read a book to your child. Encourage them to talk about the pictures. What can you see?	Use objects from home such as pebbles, buttons or lolly sticks. How many objects can you count? Can you line them up or arrange them to make a pattern?
Day 6	Make a set of family flash cards. Take a photo/draw a picture of members of your family and get a grown up to write the name next to the picture - can you start to remember which picture goes with the writing - what does the writing say?	Go on a word hunt around your house - are there any words that you already recognise? ('coke', 'family', 'crayon'...)	Find some buttons or some dry pasta. Can you count out the 3 objects into a pot? Can you count 5 objects?
Day 7	Draw a picture of your favourite animal or a pet you have at home. Tell your grown up everything you know about that animal. Can you write what it is?	Read a book to your child. Day 8	Create a dance / exercise routine / movement showing the different ways animals move. Get a grown up to record it and talk about the different animals you included. Day 9	Building time - what have you got in your house that you can use to build? (blocks are great, but you can use tins, toilet rolls or amazon boxes!) What can you build with these - can you build a tall tower; can you build a bed for teddy...?	Read a book to your child. Encourage them to talk about the pictures. What can you see?	Ask a grown up to write some numbers on paper. Hide them around the room. When you find them see if you can clap your hands that many times.
Day 10	Make a picture for a member of your family. To make them happy. Can your grown up post it to them whilst outdoors doing your exercise? Don't forget to add a stamp!	Choose another story to watch!
