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| Day 1 | <p>Read story, 'Alien's Loves Underpants'</p> <p>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=ADnAGBWlZqE</p> <p>Talk to each other about the underpants you saw in the story. What were your favourite patterned underpants?</p> | <p>Read a book to your child. Encourage them to talk about the pictures. What can you see?</p> | <p>Watch these number rhymes. | Day 2 | <p>Can you find different patterns around the house? Can you see any spotty, zigzag, stripy, or wavy patterns?</p>  | <p>Read this funny story. | Day 3 | <p>Can you draw a pair of underpants with your favourite pattern on them? You can use any tools you like such as: paints, pens, crayons etc.</p> | <p>Do you like the patterned fish? 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| Day 4 | Go on an underpants hunt. Can you find different sized pants around your house? Can you talk about big and small pants and sort them into the correct piles? | Watch the story of Elmer. How was Elmer different to the other elephants? https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=TUepS9yGANQ | You are going to make a Number Block street. Make 3 Number Block houses using old boxes. Make sure that house number 1 has 1 window and number 1 on the door. Make sure that house number 2 has 2 windows and number 2 on the door. Make sure that house number 3 has 3 windows and number 3 on the door. |
| Day 5 | Make a washing line with string. Can you hang five pants on the line? Use your strong pinchy fingers to open the peg and hang them up. Play a game listening to your grown-up's instructions. Grown up, for example ask your child, "Find me the spotty pants. Find me the stripy pants." Re-visit pattern vocabulary in this way, 'Spotty', 'stripy', 'zig, zag', 'wavy'. | Read a book to your child. Encourage them to talk about the pictures. What can you see? | Can your child make a Number Block using Lego or bricks? Make Number Block 1, 2 and 3. Can you find the right colours to match the Number Blocks? Write the numbers 1, 2 and 3 on sticky notes or pieces of paper. Can you match your numbers to the house they made yesterday? Can each Number Block walk through the right front door? |
| Day 6 | Use any boxes or indoor resources to make your own alien. You can get creative! They can have many eyes or legs or arms. Have fun! Take some photos to share. | The bear is going to the moon in his box Enjoy this story. Can you find a box and you can go on a journey too. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=m0XQ9YhWd_Y | Listen to the story of Goldilocks. You can use your imagination and take your alien to space! | Read a book to your child. Encourage them to talk about the pictures. What can you see? | Use objects from home such as pebbles, buttons or lolly sticks. How many objects can you count? Can you line them up or arrange them to make a pattern? |
| Day 8 | Can you sing, make noises, dance, and move like an alien?
