How many of your toys can you count?</p>

Day 3	<p>Can you make your own puppet to help you retell the story?</p> 	<p>Can you find a bear story at home that is your favourite?</p>	<p>Watch Number Blocks 4:  <a href="https://youtu.be/Xket7YPSCYk">https://youtu.be/Xket7YPSCYk</a>          What do you notice?</p>
Day 4	<p>Can you sing along to our new song about Goldilocks?</p> <p><a href="https://youtu.be/PFXE3zvXbjc">https://youtu.be/PFXE3zvXbjc</a></p>	<p>Listen to our rhyming story about a bear called 'Brown Bear'. Make 4 Number Block houses using old boxes. Make sure that house number 1 has 1 window and number 1 on the door. Make sure that house number 2 has 2 windows and number 2 on the door. Make sure that house number 3 has 3 windows and number 3 on the door etc</p>
Day 5	<p>Can you make some yummy porridge for your breakfast just like Mummy Bear did? Discuss what ingredients you need to add and what your favourite topping was? Was your porridge too hot, too cold, or just, right?</p>	<p>Read a book to your child. Encourage them to talk about the pictures. What can you see?</p>	<p>Can your child make a Number Block using Lego or bricks? Make Number Block 1, 2, 3 and 4. Can you find the right colours to match the Number Blocks? Write the numbers 1, 2, 3 and 4 on sticky notes or pieces of paper. Can you match your numbers to the house they made yesterday? Can each Number Block walk through the right front door?</p>
Day 6	<p>Use any boxes or indoor resources to make your own bear cottage. What will you use to make the windows,</p>	<p>The bear is going to the moon in his box. Enjoy this story! Can you find a box and you can go on a journey too?</p>	<p>Listen to the story of Goldilocks.
