Choose **one** of these tasks to complete:

Make your own model of a Roman Villa or Celtic Round house!

You may choose to design and make your own model of a Roman Villa or Celtic Round House.

Research what these would have looked like and make a plan for your model, with labels. Remember to include why your design would be suitable for a Celtic or Roman family.

Make your model out of junk modelling.

Be inspired by Roman art!

Research Roman mosaics, and collect some images of your favourite mosaics. Write about where and why mosaics would have been found.

Create your own mosaic of a Roman image. You could use squares of card, paper, foil, plastic or anything else suitable!

Roman invention scrapbook

How much do you know about Roman inventions? Find out about famous Roman inventions such as: Aqueducts, concrete, central heating, straight roads.

How did their work influence life today?

Make a scrapbook using downloaded images and drawings and write informative sentences and captions.

Feast!

Research the types of food that were traditionally eaten by wealthy ancient Romans. Create a menu for a Roman Feast! Think about how you could present this in an inventive way (e.g. an ancient scroll).

You might even like to try and cook a traditional ancient Roman dish, and bring it in for your teacher to try!
