Bug Club Reading Books

Dear Parents,

I am writing to remind you of a wonderful resource that our school buys into called 'Bug Club' <https://www.activelearnprimary.co.uk/login?c=0>. Bug Club is an online library for your child, full of books that have been allocated specifically to meet their level of reading and support them at home. Children love using this interactive resource as the books are fun and engaging. You can access Bug Club on tablets, phones and any computer so you can even read on the go!



Whilst the children can only change their reading book once a week, due to the need to quarantine them for 48 hours, it is so important that your child accesses Bug Club so that they are practising enough at home. Teachers are able to monitor how often the children access Bug Club and how many books they have read at home. It is the expectation that children read at least one Bug Club book a week.

Bug Club is particularly effective in engaging reluctant readers and as an extra resource to support struggling readers. As mentioned, all books allocated have been matched to each child's ability and so, when used regularly, will enable children to make excellent progress. Each book has 'bugs' which ask the children comprehension questions which link directly the reading curriculum for their level and so the pressure to think of your own questions is taken away.
