Dear Parents and Carers,

Postponement of Year 2 to Year Y6 PTA Magic Shows and Discos

I do hope that you are well, although I am obviously all too aware of increased cases of Covid-19 within our community. I do hope that those who have tested positive aren't feeling too poorly.

While we are all really disappointed at not being able to invite parents into school, please be assured that the children are enjoying some lovely Christmas activities. As I write this, the Reception children are performing "A Miracle in Town" and I can hear other children singing carols. Our hall looks glorious with our Christmas tree and all the Christmas hoops that each class and Hedgerows have made.

We continue to review the situation with Covid here at school and closely monitor the number of cases, as well as the symptoms children are displaying. Please read my other letter sent with this PMX. As such, and in discussion with the PTA Committee, we have taken the difficult, but necessary decision to **postpone the Year 2 to Year 6 events that have been organised for after school next week.** In short, the reason for this is that it seems rather wreckless to get all the children together for additional activities right before Christmas. Things are difficult enough with regards to the 'usual school day' with higher than normal levels of absence, both staff and children and lots of other staff feeling poorly. As of today, we have 30 positive cases (compared to 23 when I wrote to you on 30th November 2021).

The Reception and Year 1 Magic Shows, scheduled for during the school day, WILL go ahead. This is because of their timing within the school day and also because this is no different from the children rehearsing and performing their Christmas productions in the hall together as a year group which is what they have been doing. Also, our junior children are only getting together as a full cohort outdoors at present. Additionally, the Reception and Year 1 activities are staffed by teachers, whereas the after school activities would require additional PTA helpers.
