Tips for recording a talking book

Listen to a talking book. See how the storyteller uses his or her voice.

Listen to each other reading before you record the story. Provide feedback to help each other to improve.

Add sound effects. They will make the story more interesting.

Find a quiet place to record the story.

Practise using the microphone and audio recorder.

Don't worry if you don't get it right first time! Re-recording is easy.

Save your work!



Re-record – When you record something again if you're not happy with it.
