## **Arrangements for Christmas Singing After School**

## Week Commencing 6th December 2021

Further to previous correspondence, you will already be aware that we have arranged to perform some Christmas songs after school next week, on separate days for Years 3 to 6.

I am writing to confirm that the arrangements will be as follows.

ALL KS2 children are expected to attend.

The singing events are as follows:

Year 4 – Monday 6<sup>th</sup> December

Year 5 - Tuesday 7th December

Year 3 - Wednesday 8th December

Year 6 - Friday 10<sup>th</sup> December

At the end of the day, class teachers will take the children down to the Year 1 classrooms, only once all Year 1 children have been dismissed. Each KS2 class will leave their belongings in one of the Year 1 classrooms and make their way out into the Year 1 outside area to assemble under the canopy. We will aim for a 3.30pm start but obviously ask that you bear with us given that we need to make our way from the junior classrooms once Year 1 have gone, get prepared etc.

Although the gates will open at 3.00pm as usual, we ask that junior parents without other children to collect, wait outside until 3.20pm to enable us to safely dismiss Year 1.

Parents will assemble around the Year 1 fenced off area.
