NEU Industrial Action – Tuesday 2nd May 2023

Further to previous correspondence regarding industrial action impacting schools, I write to confirm the situation for next **Tuesday 2**nd **May 2023.**

The action will result in Barrow Hedges being closed for 13 of its classes next Tuesday. The following classes will be **OPEN** and children are expected to attend as usual.

Our after school clubs, which are run by external providers on Tuesday, will go ahead as normal and all children, including those whose classes are closed due to the strike, will be able to attend. A separate communication will be sent to those parents whose children attend a Tuesday club and this will include a form to complete – please do look out for this and respond as soon as possible so that we will make the necessary arrangements. Hedgerows will run as usual for those children who are booked on, as will tutoring.

When making any decisions to close or partially close the school, please be aware there are many factors to consider. This includes the health and safety aspects of a reduced staff capacity including adequate supervision, necessary first aid cover and the required safeguarding provision.

Finally, I absolutely recognise the disruption that this causes for parents and carers which is why we have wanted to provide you with this information at our earliest opportunity. I know that the decision the teachers
