Movement (A style of art followed by a group of artists during a certain period in time)

Impressionist

- Impressionism focussed on creating artwork that showed how the artist saw everyday life, practising using light, shadows, and colours.
- Impressionist painters often used broken, bold brush strokes that can easily be seen.

Claude Monet



DOB: 14th November 1840-
5th December 1926

Nationality: French, born in Paris.

Mediums he used (refer to both to the type of art (e.g. painting, sculpture, printmaking), as well as the materials an artwork is made from).

Monet mostly used oil paints, with bold brushstrokes to paint his nature scenes. As young artist he started off with charcoal as his preferred medium.



FUN FACT: Later in life Monet started to lose his eyesight. Frustrated by this, he would paint using bold
