Chess club is for learners. **Children should know how each piece moves and captures before joining the club.** PLACES ARE OPEN TO ALL, AND NOT HELD FROM ONE TERM TO THE NEXT. PLACES ARE LIMITED AND ARE ON A FIRST-COME-FIRST SERVED BASIS EACH TERM.

#### *Why play chess?*

Chess is fun, it is a lifetime hobby, but it is also so much more. ***Chess is a game that involves strategy, risk management, creative thinking, and the ability to manage your emotions.***

- Chess is about ***making decisions, analysing the problems, abstract reasoning.***
- Chess is a fantastic tool for ***developing character*** at a young age such as *resilience, patience, sportsmanship.* Understand that decisions have consequences, “**growth mind-set**” – learns from setbacks.
- Chess also brings together all ages, nationalities, backgrounds, and gender.

In the club children will have fun learning with children of similar age. During the club the children are taught various tactics, opening and endgames. They will solve chess puzzles in a tutored, interactive class setting.

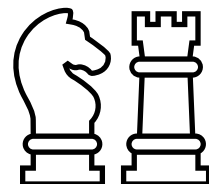
