### Tremors

Choose **one** of these tasks to complete:

Children will present their topic homework to the rest of the class to develop their speaking and listening skills.

#### Volcano poster

*You may wish to design a poster to show a volcano's main features. Make sure you label its important parts.*

#### Why do people live close to a volcano?

*You may choose to find out why people still live close to volcanoes despite the risks. Think about soil, new land, building materials, mineral deposits, hot springs and spas, electricity and tourism. Be ready to share your ideas with the rest of the class.*

#### Research

*You may choose to research a volcanic eruption of your choice (not one you've studied in class). Produce a fact file about the eruption including:*

- a) *A map to show its location*
- b) *A description of the eruption*
- c) *An explanation of why it erupted*
- d) *Details about the eruption's impact (both short and long term)*
